The Ohio Department has multiple reasons to be proud of activities that occurred in Milwaukee at our recent Encampment. Those appointed to the floor: Ramona Greenwalt, PDP guide and National Chief of Staff, Wanda Langdon AP #10 outside guard, Judy Brown and Barbara Lynch #10 Color Guards #1 and #2. Our own Becca Freshley of Garfield Auxiliary was awarded the National scholarship while her mother Sue Freshley AP of Garfield looked on. At the banquet, Perley Mellor, Past Commander-in-Chief awarded Jane Graham, PNP with the Dr. Mary Edward Walker Award for her efforts throughout her membership towards the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War on every level. We BUCKEYES should be mighty proud of each of these Sisters.

The following actions were passed at the Encampment:

- 1. Per Capita to increase to \$9.00 per year per member effective January 1, 2014.
- 2. Application fee for each new member to increase to \$10.00, effective immediately.
- 3. Tertiary reports will no longer be used effective in 2014. We will be filing our annual report and paying per capita tax once per year. This will be due in what used to be your April report. That means that in that report you will be sending #13.50 per Sister to the Ohio Department Secretary. The Department will keep \$4.50 for our expenses and send the remaining \$9.00 to National. If you are not collecting dues in a timely manner and have a small treasury, now is the time to get with these Sisters and take care of these matters.
