The Department Chief of Staff is an appointment made by the Department President at the time of her installation. If you know anything of military history, the Chief of Staff "runs the show", but is also responsible for paying the bills. Her funds collected pay any bills required for the Department Encampment, which can include anything from a hotel bill for our National President to a luncheon ticket for our Department President and more. She is required to raise almost twice as much as the Patriotic Instructor and each Auxiliary is to send her a minimum of \$25 towards her fund.
